Mansfield Paper Shredding Rescheduled for August 29, 2020

On August 29 Mansfield residents can bring bags or boxes of paper to be shredded on site at the Mansfield transfer station, 221 Warrenville Road, Mansfield Center. The cost will be \$3.00 for the equivalent amount of a medium sized box of paper (approximately 12" x 10" x 17"). There is no limit on the amount of paper brought in per car.
