How can AARP Foundation Tax-Aide Help you with your Federal & State Tax Returns during the COVID-19 Pandemic

AARP Foundation Tax-Aide has been helping low – moderate income seniors prepare and file their federal and state tax returns since 1968, however on March 16th in response to the COVID-19 situation, our operations across the nation were suspended and remain closed for the safety of our volunteers and taxpayers.

As our sites remain closed and the Governor urges those 65 and older to stay home, the program continues to look for ways to help the many taxpayers who had not yet filed their 2019 federal and state tax returns and while the deadline has been extended until July 15th, we simply do not know if our sites will re-open during this extended tax season.

While we may not be able to prepare your taxes for you at this time, AARP Foundation Tax-Aide is providing access to selected tax preparation software so taxpayers can prepare and file their own tax returns at NO COST through the Free File Alliance.
