Dear Mansfield and E.O. Smith Families,


Effective today breakfast and lunch meals are **FREE** for all children 18 and younger. This federally mandated benefit will be in effect until December 31st, 2020, unless funds are exhausted sooner by the United States Department of Agriculture.

Please read the following:

- If you previously qualified, or believe you may qualify, please **CONTINUE** to submit free and reduced meal applications as soon as possible.
 - Even though all students can receive meals for free, we still need to verify your status for when the federal extension expires.
- You may continue to add money to your child's account. It will remain there for when the federal extension expires. They may also use funds (grades 5-12) to make a la carte purchases. A milk only purchase is still \$0.50.
- If you already received an eligibility notification letter from us, the free, reduced, paid status indicated will go into effect when the federal extension expires.
- If you would like remote meals, for either 5 days, or 3 days, and you haven't already – please complete the survey here <https://forms.gle/hTzLNu3AA3YVECUPA> and food services will get in touch with you to arrange a meal pick-up process.




Itty Bitty Sports


