


## Concert Dress:

Thank you for your help with this important fundraising activity. Last year we raised almost \$1000.00. Let's see if we can bring in even more this year.


Please remember, it is helpful if you:

Kindergarten Student Visitation Day at Goodwin School will be Thursday, May 21, 2015 at 8:00-3:50. Children entering Kindergarten for the 2015-2016 school year must be five years of age on or before January 1, 2016. Please call or email the office to set up an appointment if you did not set one up during Parent Orientation Night.

Your child needs to be present and will be meeting with Mr. O'Donnell and Mrs. Clark, our Kindergarten teachers. Please plan to stay for approximately 1 hour. If you have a health concern regarding your child our nurse Mrs. Wiant-Rudd will be available at the visitation for questions.

**The Registration forms that you received at the Parent Orientation need to be completed and presented at this visit.**

**FORMS DUE DURING THIS VISIT**

- Birth Certificate.
- Proof of Mansfield residency (examples: utility bill, lease or mortgage).
- The health exam record, completed by physician. DUE NOW OR BEFORE AUGUST 1<sup>st</sup>. (may be mailed)
- The registration form (completed).
- The language survey form (completed).
- The location of residence form (completed).
- The kindergarten screening-parent questionnaire (completed).
- The green Long Term Transportation form (completed)

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOUR CHILD **WILL NOT** BE PERMITTED TO START THE 2015-2016 SCHOOL YEAR UNTIL PROOF OF RESIDENCY, BIRTH CERTIFICATE, RECORD OF IMMUNIZATIONS AND PHYSICAL EXAMINATION FORMS ARE PRESENTED




### GOALS

## Welcome to Camp Mansfield



The day camp operates Monday-Friday from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. for full-day campers. Additional camp care hours of 7:30-9 a.m. and 3-5:30 p.m.

We are pleased to offer a large variety of organized and well staffed activities including but not limited to; nature, archery, swimming, canoeing, hiking, arts & crafts, sports, creative games, special events, variety and more. ### Camp Program Description

**KinderCamp**—Monday-Friday, 9a.m.—noon for children entering Kindergarten. Outdoor games, sports, crafts, nature, swimming, and more. A lunch is provided.

**Children entering Kindergarten have a choice.** Choose either 1/2 day KinderCamp or Full day Explorers Camp.  
**Explorers**—Monday-Friday from 9a.m.—3p.m. for children entering grades K-6. Includes outdoor games, sports, nature, drama, archery, arts & crafts, creative games, canoeing, kayaking, swimming lessons, open swim, and special events. Lunch is provided.

**Adventurers**—Monday-Friday, 9a.m.—3p.m. for children entering grades 7-9. Those entering grade 9, have a choice of the Adventurers OR C.I.T. programs. Campers participate in the same activities listed under "Explorers" plus have off site adventure trips, which may include hiking, rock climbing, tubing and more. Trip fees are included in the fee and a daily lunch is provided. Space in this program is limited.

**Counselor-In-Training**—Monday-Friday for teens entering grades 9th & 10th (11th Grade if not yet 16). Designed for developing leadership skills in the area of child development, activity planning, and group games. Maximum age is 16.

**Campers with Special Needs**—campers who require additional support or adaptations will participate inclusively within their same age/grade. Special assistance forms must be completed a minimum of 15 working days prior to the start of a new session.

**Camp Care**—Designed for working parents who require additional care for their child beyond the regular camp hours. Available to full day campers, 7:30-9 a.m. and/or 3-5:30 p.m. Monday-Friday. Also available for 1/2 day kinder-campers (am care only).
