
Dear Goodwin Families,

We hope that you will enjoy the journey along with us.




From Route 44 East:

- Turn Right on Storrs Road/CT-195
- Turn Right onto North Eagleville Road
- Turn Right onto North Hillside Road
- Turn Right onto Tower Court Road
- Park anywhere in the parking lot.



From Route 84 East

- Take EXIT 68, CT-195, toward Tolland/Mansfield
- Turn Right onto CT-195, continue on CT-195 for approximately 7 miles
- Turn Right onto North Eagleville Road
- Turn Right onto North Hillside Road
- Turn Right onto Tower Court Road
- Park anywhere in the parking lot



From Route 84 West

- Take EXIT 70, CT-32 toward Willington/Willimantic
- Turn Left onto CT-195, continue on CT-195 for approximately 4 miles
- Turn Right onto North Eagleville Road
- Turn Right onto North Hillside Road
- Turn Right onto Tower Court Road
- Park anywhere in the parking lot
