Dear Parent/Guardian,

In compliance with Connecticut State Statute, 19a-62a, the Mansfield Board of Education, requires that MMS students have a health assessment completed (School Physical) during their 6<sup>th</sup> grade year.

**For students entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade in the 2016-2017 school year, a physical examination is acceptable if it is conducted between May 1, 2016 and May 31, 2017 and includes:**

- Updated immunizations: (Including Varicella, Tdap and Meningococcal) \*
- Tuberculin risk assessment completed by the physician/APRN/PA
- Chronic disease assessment completed by the physician/APRN/PA
- Blood work for anemia (hemoglobin/hematocrit)

Note: Some of the required immunizations must be given on or after your child's 11<sup>th</sup> birthday. Please keep this in mind when scheduling an appointment.

Copies of the state required HAR form can be obtained from the MMS website listed below. When your child is seen for his/her physical, please have the provider complete this Health Assessment Record. Please note that page-one of the HAR should be completed by the parent/guardian. Please complete this section prior to returning the forms.

We encourage you to schedule this exam during the summer months so that it does not get overlooked during the busy school year. We also suggest that this important form is brought to the health room by an adult or sent via the mail. Students are not always the most reliable form of mail delivery.
