

Permitting and Code Enforcement Software RFQ Questions

- *Does the Town have a budget for the purposes of this RFQ? If so, what is it?*
The Town does not release budget information as part of the RFQ process.
- *What is the Town's existing GIS environment? Does the Town have Arc GIS Server Standard or above?*
The Town's GIS system is coordinated by a third party, [Main Street GIS](#). The Town does have a limited number of ArcGIS licenses (version 10) that are used by staff for individual projects.
- *With regard to handheld devices, have you researched and found any units that meet your specifications? If so, what manufacturer and equipment did you find?*
No.
- *Do we need to integrate with IPV6?*
No.
- *Does the Town have aerials? (There are licensing issues with Google Maps.)*
Yes.
- *Can you describe "protected individuals" who need to have name and address redacted? (We haven't seen this request before!)*
Please see Connecticut General Statutes Section 1-217 for the protected classes.
- *Do you have administrative hearings (Code Enforcement) or are these cases going to Court?*
Most cases use an administrative hearing procedure.
- *Do you know if the Dept. of Consumer Protection has a web service layer? If not, are you currently getting an export of their data?*
No to both.
- *Is the City looking for a hosted (Software as a Service) environment?*
More often than not, the town would prefer a hosted (software as a service) model due to its inherent advantages, however it is not a requirement of the RFP and the town will consider both hosted and non-hosted proposals.
