CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS: MAKING A SUBSTANTIAL INVESTMENT

The Town uses its capital improvement program (CIP) to maintain roads and other infrastructure, and to buy new trucks and other large equipment costing \$5000 or more. Our capital needs average \$1.5—\$2 million per year.

With the new budget year, we are taking advantage of some modest new tax revenue and declining education expenditures in order to make a larger general fund investment of \$1,014,210 in our CIP. This investment from the general fund, combined with other revenue sources, will allow the Town to begin to finance all regular, recurring capital projects and initiatives on a pay-as-you-go or cash basis, creating a more stable funding source for the CIP and enabling the Town to replace equipment and infrastructure on a timelier basis, avoiding more costly repairs and maintenance expenditures. The Town would still need to issue debt for major initiatives such as school construction and large public works projects. This pay-as-you-go financing model will minimize the amount of debt we need to issue and will potentially improve our bond rating, creating long-term savings for everyone.
