## HOUSEHOLDS WITH FRIDAY COLLECTION:

Beginning the week of November 1, 2010, trash and recycling will be collected on WEDNESDAYS instead of FRIDAYS. As of November 1, 2010 there will no longer be trash and recycling collection on Fridays. Place trash and recyclables out on Tuesday evenings for Wednesday service.

### TRASH & RECYCLING COLLECTION SERVICE

The week of Thanksgiving - Thursday service will be moved to Friday. Wednesday service will stay on Wednesday.

The weeks of Christmas and New Year's - no change in trash service days.

### EXTRA HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

The week of December 27 you may put out extra household garbage on your collection day. Extra garbage does not include bulky items, which should be taken to the transfer station.

### HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY

The remaining Saturdays that the Willington Household Chemical Waste Drop-Off Facility will be open in 2010 are October 16 & November 6 from 9 am until 2 pm. All residents and small businesses are encouraged to use it. Small businesses should make arrangements with the facility first by calling (860) 289-2296.

### FESTIVAL ON THE GREEN

Mansfield celebrated its seventh Festival on the Green, Sunday, September 12, 2010. A concerted effort was made to minimize the amount of waste. By composting the food service items (plates, bowls & utensils made from corn or potatoes) and recycling cans, cups and bottles, 87% of the day's waste was composted and recycled.
