



Mansfield Pup Crawl – Spring Edition!

May 9, 2016 – The Mansfield Downtown Partnership invites residents and visitors to the spring edition of the Mansfield Pup Crawl this Saturday, May 14. Participants and their four-legged friends will meet on the Town Square at 9:30 AM for a guided walk through Downtown Storrs. The walk will be approximately 1.7 miles and will conclude at the Town Square. This event is free and open to the public. Donations for the Friends of Mansfield Animal Shelter will be gratefully accepted.

The Mansfield Pup Crawl provides a great opportunity to check out the latest developments in Storrs Center, meet new friends, and enjoy a pleasant walk with your dog(s). There will be stops along the way, which will take participants through the downtown and into the Albert E. Moss Sanctuary.

All dogs must be on a leash and up-to-date with their shots. Participants are asked to be prepared to clean up after their dog(s) as needed. The Mansfield Pup Crawl will take place rain or shine.

Parking in the Storrs Center Garage is free for the first two hours and \$1 per hour thereafter, with a daily maximum charge of \$8. The Dog Lane Parking Lot offers free parking with a 2 hour limit. Handicapped parking is available in these locations as well.
