CTtransit Coming to Storrs Center *Will Service Nash-Zimmer Transportation Center*

August 10, 2017 – Beginning Sunday, August 13, Mansfield residents will have a new option for traveling to Manchester and Hartford: CTtransit will start service to the Nash-Zimmer Transportation Center (23 Royce Circle in Storrs Center).

The CTtransit 913 Hartford/Buckland/Storrs Express will operate on an hourly schedule with stops at:

- UConn campus – Whitney Hall
- Route 195 at Route 44 (Four Corners)
- Tolland park and ride lot
- Buckland Hills Mall
- Manchester – Buckland park and ride
- Downtown Hartford at Central Row
- Union Station, Hartford
- CTfastrak Sigourney Street station, Hartford

At the Sigourney Street station, commuters can transfer to CTfastrack Route 121 to reach UConn Health in Farmington.

Fares will range from \$3.20 to ride to Tolland to \$5.00 to ride to Hartford. Discounts are available for senior citizens and disabled riders. Exact fare is required.

CTtransit offers a range of pre-paid fare payment options, including 10-Ride Tickets and 31-Day Passes. Tickets & passes are sold at the CTtransit Sales Outlet at State House Square in downtown Hartford and can be ordered online at cttransit.com.

UConn students are eligible to ride the bus at no charge by showing their student ID and a pass obtained through the CT UPass Program (<http://web2.uconn.edu/parking/hfdstudentparking/>).
