## STORRS CENTER: SHAPING UP!


### *A Look Around Downtown*

Construction continues apace in [Storrs Center](#) with several private and public projects underway.

In the Town Square neighborhood, building TS-3 can be seen to the south of the future Town Square. As with the other buildings in this neighborhood, TS-3 will be five stories with commercial uses on the first floor and additional apartments by The Oaks on the Square on the upper floors. The building will be completed by August 2014. The Oaks has begun accepting applications for leases for this building, along with One and Nine Dog Lane and One Royce Circle, and the response has been strong. The Nash-Zimmer Transportation Center will provide space for pedestrians, public transit users, and bicyclists to gather, wait for buses, store bicycles, and access the shared car program. The Partnership office will be on the second floor.

Also underway in the Town Square neighborhood is the Town Square itself. Work on the Town Square will continue through the winter, weather permitting, with expected completion in summer 2014.

Across the street, the Nash-Zimmer Transportation Center is nearing completion. This building (adjacent to the parking garage, depicted in yellow on the concept plan on page 1) is expected to open by the end of November. The Mansfield Downtown Partnership expects to move its office to the second floor of this building in December.

When TS-3, the Nash-Zimmer Transportation Center, and the Town Square are finished, the Town Square neighborhood will be nearly

complete. There is room for an additional building, which had been proposed to be a hotel. Following Mansfield's Planning and Zoning Commission's decision not to permit hotel use on this site, LeylandAlliance is considering other options (the building depicted in red to the right of TS-3 on the concept plan).

Another neighborhood that will be taking shape in 2014 is the Market Square neighborhood. The new Price Chopper building is under construction across the street from Town Hall and is expected to open in the summer. A second, smaller commercial building will be constructed at the corner of Charles Smith Way (formerly "Post Office Road") and S. Eagleville Road (Route 275). This building will be approximately 5,000 square feet and will have commercial tenants. Master developer LeylandAlliance is in discussions with

interested parties, but no lease has been signed yet for this space. When the Town's Planning and Zoning Commission approved the special permit application for Price Chopper, they required that the second building (MP-2) be constructed at the same time as Price Chopper.

Lastly, [Educational Playcare](#) is working on finalizing its plans for a childcare facility on Wilbur Cross Way (depicted in blue on the concept plan on page 1). Educational Playcare is a family-owned and operated business with locations in Avon, Farmington, Simsbury, Wallingford, and Windsor. They offer programs for children aged 6 weeks and up, focusing on daycare and preschool programs. Educational Playcare hopes to open in the summer.



With the first phase (Phase 1 - Town Square Neighborhood) nearly complete, Storrs Center is becoming the promised town center, where friends meet while walking from shop to shop, families gather for celebratory meals, residents of all ages sit and enjoy some live music, children hurry to their favorite sweet shop, and visitors come for special events.

"We are very pleased with the progress to date and look forward to the next phases opening," said Partnership Executive Director Cynthia van Zelm. "After over a decade of planning and working through a significant recession, it is gratifying to have all of the commercial spaces and all of the apartments leased and continuing, strong demand for more amenities." ♦
