Dear Mansfield Town Council,

Unfortunately, I am out of the country and unable to attend the above-referenced meeting. However, I would like to take this opportunity to voice my support for this project and have it read into the Public Hearing record.

I first came to Mansfield to attend the University of CT in 1962 (where I met my wife to be). After graduation, we returned here to start a family, where we have resided ever since. Aside from being a resident (Stone Mill Rd) my family and I are owners of commercial property (Storrs Commons), office property (Mansfield Professional Park) and an undeveloped land parcel (Route 195, just past Four Corners). The latter two are in the project area.

Both as citizens of the community and affected property owners, my family and I wholeheartedly support the "Four Corners" sewer collection, water contamination and waste water disposal project. We feel it will promote conservative and desirable commercial growth in Town, significantly add to Mansfield's tax base and create many new, short and long term jobs. Further, it will remove the unsightly and inappropriate blight which has plagued the Four Corners, the entrance to our greater community, for even longer than we've been in the area.

I understand that as citizen taxpayers, as well as property owners in the project area, my family and I will bear a significant amount of the costs involved in implementing the project. However, representing both of those roles, we feel the community, as well as the directly affected property owners, will be well served by these long overdue and desperately needed improvements.
