Director of Human Services – Pat said that a Program Supervisor may be hired by the end of this week. A part-time van driver will be hired using grant money so the van can be better utilized. Pat introduced Carolyn McAuliffe, who said she is getting to know the community and its needs. She is working 19 hours per week.

Senior Center Supervisor – Cindy handed out copies of Senior Happenings. The Center will be closed June 23-27 for cleaning and painting. She reminded us of the evening program on July 3 that will include supper and a performance by a magician. The annual Mansfield Festival will be held at the new town square on September 21 and it was suggested that we might like to have a table with the Senior Center.

Community News – Emile and Martina reported that things are going well at both Rolling Hills and Juniper Hill. The chairman reminded us that a representative is needed from Glen Ridge.

New Business – There will be three vacancies on this commission next fall and members were encouraged to reach out to people who would be willing to serve.

Old Business - Will circulated a letter to the Town Council he drafted asking that a bus shelter with seats be installed at the stop nearest the Community Center. A few revisions were suggested and the letter will be read at the Council meeting June 9. The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
