

Historic District Commission  
Minutes Tuesday, May 10, 2016

Members Present: Dave Spencer, Gail Bruhn

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. in Conference Room B, Mansfield Town Hall

Old Business:

1. The minutes from the April meeting were approved.
2. Nancy Flynn of the First Baptist Church, Spring Hill Historic District submitted a sign proposal for the Church. She had reviewed several ideas before the Committee in February. Her comments follow, with sign design at bottom:

"I attended the Historical District Commission meeting in February of 2016 and discussed replacing the sign for the First Baptist Church of Mansfield in the Spring Hill Historical District. We have pursued the design with Signs of All Kinds in Manchester Connecticut and have raised sufficient funds to move forward. At this point I am sending you the design and dimensions for approval by the commission. The current sign is 48" x 41" and stands a total of 76" from the ground. It is our intention to match the color of the sign as close as possible to the red color of the sanctuary doors. The sign would remain in the vicinity of the current sign and would be turned 180 degrees so each side could be seen by those passing by on route 195."

The proposed sign seemed somewhat different from what Dave and Gail recalled seeing in February, and it was agreed that Gail would follow up with Nancy to confirm design details.

New Business: Lesley Dyson has resigned from the Commission, as she is selling her house and moving out of town. Dave and Gail will work to come up with potential candidates for membership.
