Minutes of the Meeting
December 22, 2009

Present: Hultgren, Meitzler, Jackman, Kodzis

Pedestrian awareness campaign – Hultgren reported that the UConn committee had met recently but they did not consider the joint marketing program with the Town. He said he e-mailed the chairperson suggesting the Town and University work together on this.

195 Bus stops near Clover Mill Road – no progress

Signal Timing Route 32 at S. Eagleville Road – At DOT's request, an e-mail was sent to DOT Traffic requesting the loops be repaired so the signal could function as intended. Traffic Authority members will monitor the backups at this signal so that DOT can be informed of it's performance.

Wrights Way Bus Shelter Request – no progress, waiting for Mansfield bus stop activity data from WRTD.

Hidden Dive Sign Request near 147 Chaffeeville Road – Hultgren said the measured sight distance of 300 feet (looking North) was marginal for traffic under 40 mph and inadequate for traffic traveling southbound at greater than 40 mph. Meitzler will sample southbound speeds at this location.

Willowbrook Road Neighborhood Concerns – Hultgren said that “no parking on circle” signs would be re-installed near the west end of Willowbrook. Other issues will be discussed at the January meeting.

Baxter Road Sign Request – A “through traffic” sign with an arrow pointing west down Rockridge Road will be placed at the Baxter/Rockridge intersection so that traffic coming north on Baxter will see that the road does not continue north into Willington.

North Eagleville Road Street Lighting Request – It was determined that lights are missing at one of the Meadowood intersections and the Northwood Road intersection. These will be ordered after first requesting that UConn put up the light at Northwood.
