

Town of Mansfield Traffic Authority  
Minutes of the Meeting – November 22, 2011

Present: Hultgren, Meitzler, Painter, Hart, Jackman

The meeting began at approximately 9:33 am and there were no corrections to the minutes of the October 25, 2011 meeting.

72 Mansfield City Road – no change in status -- a guardrail contractor has been hired to install the short section of guardrail along Mansfield City Road, which is expected to be done soon.

Hillyndale, Baxter, Hanks Hill Road – as discussed at the previous meeting, letters were written to the residents that had requested speed controls on these roads.

Ravine Road – Hultgren reported that a field trip had taken place with UConn transportation and sign officials and he was writing a letter to DOT traffic requesting additional directional signs to UConn on Routes 44 and 32. The custom Town sign for North Eagleville Road has been ordered and will be put up when it comes in.

Chaffeeville Road speed concerns – Hultgren has located a place on the Route 195 end of Chaffeeville Road where the speed trailer can be located.

Walk Facing Traffic sign requests – signs have been received and will be placed on Hunting Lodge Road between Separatist Road and North Eagleville. Hultgren will check with DOT traffic to see if they could be placed on South Eagleville Road between Maple and Separatist Roads.

Parking ordinance revisions – Hultgren said that the Town Attorney wanted to add a specific state statute reference to the parking regulations being revised and he should have the recommended additional language early in December. A special meeting may be needed to review these prior to sending them to the Town Council. Jackman suggested that enforcing illegal parking in fire lanes by fire department personnel be added to the revisions.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 9:50 AM.
