CAMP MANSFIELD POSITIONS AND PAY RATES

Employment and wages are based on prior experience working at camps (or working with children), related job experience, facility experience (i.e. babysitting in home vs. day camp at recreation center), supervisory experience, education, certifications, past job evaluations (for returning staff), and years working at the Mansfield Parks and Recreation Department. All pay rates are subject to change.

Camp Mansfield: Work hours consist of:

1. The general camp program operates Monday - Friday, 8:45 a.m.–3:15 p.m.
2. A before and after camp care program operates Monday-Friday, 7:30–8:45 a.m. and 3:15–5:30 p.m. Most general day camp staff will be required to work some camp care hours.

Assistant Director Assists the Camp Director in daily camp operations including administrative work, supervision and training of staff, coordinates our camp supports portion of camp, which includes general assessments of special needs children (reviewing needs with parents and/or caseworkers) and supervising staff who will work 1:1 with campers, fills in for and assists specialists and counselors as needed, assists in planning of camp wide special events. Salary: \$11.81-\$14.35

Counselor-In-Training Coordinator/Head Counselor Works with young teens in grades 9-10 to develop skills in the of child development, activity planning, skill demonstration and organization and oversee and assist counselors. Salary: \$9.29-\$11.78

Preschool Coordinator Responsible for overseeing staff and program at half-day camp for camp for ages 3 1/2 - not yet entering K. Planning group passive and active recreation, arts & crafts, nature, etc. Salary: \$9.29-\$11.78

KinderCamp Specialist Responsible for overseeing staff and program for children entering kindergarten. This half and full day program includes a variety of outdoor and indoor passive and active recreation activities. Salary: \$9.29-\$11.78

Camp Specialists Designs and conducts specific activities in conjunction with entire camp program. Nature, Arts & Crafts, Variety, Sports, Games, Archery and Boating/Canoeing. Designs and instructs specialized activities for all camper age groups. Salary: \$9.29-\$11.78

Adventurer Specialists Designs and leads activities and trips with an adventure emphasis for children in grades 7, 8 & 9. Includes independent planning of two day trips and one overnight per session. Must obtain public service driver's license prior to the start of camp. Salary: \$9.29-\$11.78

Camp Supports Specialists Is a 1:1 or small group counselor to children with special needs. Children participate inclusively within camp groups. Prior experience with children with special needs is helpful but not required. Salary: \$9.29-11.78

Counselors Responsible for supervising an age group of children in grades K-6. Planning and leading a variety of passive and active games. Responsible for leading groups to and participating in a variety of outdoor and indoor activities. Salary: \$8.70-\$10.16

1/2 Time Counselors (Day Camp Leader I) Responsible for supervising an age group of children in grades Pre-School – K. Leading a variety of passive and active games. Assisting in planning of age appropriate activities. Salary: \$8.70-\$10.16
