

"Symbolism Bookmark" Book Review



This book review format will have TWO parts.

PART 1 is a **WRITTEN ESSAY**; a brief **SUMMARY, ANALYSIS, and CRITIQUE** of the novel.

- Paragraph 1: Plot summary. Include title (underlined), author, genre, and setting, the main characters (with mini description of each), along with *basic* plot.
- Paragraph 2: *One* type of conflict found in the story. Use **2-3 examples** from the story to show evidence of this *one* type of conflict.
- Paragraph 3: Give advice ~ Do you recommend this book to your peers? Why or why not?
- Proper bibliography for the book you have read at the end of your paper (this can go on to the next page.)

[**MUST be typed**, 12 point font, Times New Roman, double-spaced, 1" margins. MAX: 1 page]

PART 2 is a **BOOKMARK ART PROJECT**; represent your understanding of the novel through the use of symbolism. Using the *oak tag pattern*, create a **BOOKMARK** that represents your novel.

The FRONT includes:

- Title
- Author
- At least one **symbol** to represent **each [total of 4]: setting, conflict, theme, and one aspect of the culture portrayed (one attitude, belief, behavior, or custom)**. Use the same conflict you discussed in your written essay.
- Bold, neat, full color illustrations are required.

The BACKSIDE:

- Explain each of the four symbols. What are they? What do they represent? What evidence from the text led you to these ideas? Write one paragraph per symbol. This may be typed or hand-written.
- Your name and Lit #

NOTE: With teacher permission, you may choose to create this book review in a different format. It is up to you to see me IN ADVANCE to "pitch your idea" for approval.
