COVID-19 Update

Number of positive cases has been manageable. More than 50 reported since December break.

Substitutes have been limited but we have been able to cover needs.

Bus driver shortage of one driver on two different days. Transportation was provided on a delayed schedule.

N-95 masks distributed to all staff on two occasions. All staff have access to a minimum of 4 N-95 masks.

Test kits distributed in two waves to staff and families. More than 1,150 total.

Test kits continue to be available on an as needed basis. Any student or staff with symptoms or those who must test as part of quarantine are provided a kit.
