The meeting was called to order at 4:30pm by Ms. Picard

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: There were no corrections or objections to approving the minutes of the October 10, 2024, meeting.

Superintendent Dart thanked members of the ad hoc committee for their work in reviewing the policy manual.

Mrs. Corso reviewed the proposed document changes. These consisted of minor corrections, district corrections to reflect present practices, and a reorganization of the table of contents.

Attorney Melinda Kaufmann reviewed the policy changes recommended or required. These related to Suicide Prevention & Intervention, Retention and Disposition of Records and Information, Student Discipline, and Mandated Reporters. Superintendent Dart noted that these policies are available to parents and guardians in the district's Family Handbook, written in plain language. Ms. Ward thanked Attorney Kaufmann for her work putting the revisions together.
