Incentives for Transportation

Superintendent Dart discussed a MOU crafted by Shipman and Goodwin, Attorneys at Law, that outlines an agreement between M&J Bus Co. and the Mansfield Board of Education to provide monetary incentives to school bus drivers for specific performance, and monetary incentives for individuals signing on as new drivers. The intent of this incentive initiative is to alleviate school bus issues the district is currently experiencing.

M. Kelly presented information she has researched about school bus driver issues. She requested this information be presented at a future meeting.
