Dear Mansfield Staff and Families,

We were notified today of a positive case of COVID-19 within the Vinton School community. Contact tracing has already been concluded and all staff or students affected by this case have been notified. Once again, we know that this case originated outside of school.

We seem to be in an especially active time for this virus. As shared earlier this week, please continue to monitor your own health and that of family members. Staff and students exhibiting any of the symptoms below, or feeling ill, should stay home and call their medical provider to report their symptoms and ask about testing prior to seeking in-person care at a clinic, physician's office, or hospital.

- Fever (100.4° Fahrenheit or higher)
- Chills or shaking chills
- Uncontrolled new cough (not due to other known cause, such as chronic cough)
- Difficulty breathing or shortness of breath
- New loss of taste or smell
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Further, our protocols require that anyone experiencing these symptoms receive a negative COVID-19 test result or an alternate diagnosis from their medical provider before returning to school.
