
Dear Mansfield Staff and Families,

We have one positive case of COVID-19 to report today at Goodwin School. The person infected was not in school during the infectious period and therefore there were no direct contacts identified within the school community. The majority of recent positive cases of COVID-19 are the result of spread within one's family. This is a good reminder to continue to limit contact with those outside your own home and, as directed by public health protocols, to keep all members of your family home should anyone in the household be COVID positive.

While I am writing to you, I also want to remind everyone of our snow day allowances per the Mansfield School Calendar revised on November 12, 2020. The first three inclement weather days were designated as "no school days." Any additional days in which school must close were identified as remote learning days. Yesterday we experienced our third day of school closure due to weather issues. **Therefore, any additional days when schools cannot open due to weather related issues will be remote learning days.** Students should bring their iPads or Chromebooks home with them each day. On remote learning days, students should use SeeSaw or Google Classroom to join their homeroom/classroom teacher at the start of the school day.

Limiting no school days allows us to set a firm last day of school for 2020-21. The last day of school for students is Thursday, June 17. The last day for most staff is Friday, June 18.
