

Trees

Please call 429-3331 if you suspect a dead tree in the Town's Right-of-Way. The Department will come out to your residence and determine if the tree is dead and measure from the center of the road to determine if it is the Town's responsibility. The right-of-way is different for each road in town so we have to come out and measure for each tree.

Roadside Mowing

When does the Town start the roadside mowing? The Town has one roadside mower to cover 216 lane miles of roadside. The Department concentrates on major intersections and collector roads, proceeds to the remaining roads and then into developments. This program begins at the end of April and continues until the end of September.

Gravel Road Maintenance

The Town has 15 miles of gravel roads. The Department begins the gravel road maintenance program in April repairing the roads from winter weather. During times of heavy rains in the spring and summer, the Department will revisit certain gravel roads and spread more material. In October, the Department performs a more intensive maintenance on the gravel roads and cleans out the drainage ditches of debris and leaves.

Trash

Often residents wonder who they should call when their trash container lid falls off or when they want to put a hold of their trash service.
