Dear Mansfield Staff and Families,

We learned today that a member of the Mansfield Middle School community has tested positive for COVID-19 resulting in the need to quarantine other members of the school. Even with a significant percentage of our community population fully immunized, we must still remain vigilant, especially for individuals who have not received the vaccine.

As shared last week, there are two upcoming vaccination clinics especially for students aged 12 to 15. Parents/guardians are encouraged to attend the clinic with their child to provide consents. (If parents/guardians are not able to be present, then both consents and the questionnaire attached need to be completed and brought with the student.)

When calling state the *date and location* of the clinic you hope to attend.

Fully immunized individuals (those two weeks past their final dose) are at much less risk for contracting the virus and do not need to quarantine if exposed to someone with the virus. Receiving the vaccine is the best way to ensure uninterrupted schooling and we encourage all eligible students and staff to receive the vaccine.
