Dairy Bar - 5 mi; 292 ft of climb
 Starting point: UConn Dairy Bar Horsebarn Hill loop and a little of the UConn campus West of Rte 195

Nash-Zimmer - 6 mi; 336 ft of climb
 Starting point: Transportation Center on Royce Circle in Downtown Storrs.
 Dog Lane, Hanks Hill Rd, South Eagleville Rd, Maple Rd, Spring Hill Rd and Rte 195 just South of Downtown Storrs. (Note that Rte 195 is not signed as a Bike Route here)

Community Center - 4.0 mi; 246 ft of climb
 Starting point: Mansfield Community Ctr on South Eagleville Road.
 A loop around and through much of the northerly UConn campus via multi-use paths on Separatist and Hunting Lodge Roads and campus roadways.

Southeast - 6 mi; 333 ft of climb
 Starting point: Playing fields next to Southeast School on Rte 89.
 Loop through Mansfield Center up Chaffeeville Road, across Mulberry Road and down Wormwood Hill Road back to Rte 89.

Boat Launch - 9 mi; 536 ft of climb
 Starting point: The boat launch area in the Mansfield Hollow State Park on Bassetts Bridge Road.
 Loop through Atwoodville via N. Bedlam Road, Atwoodville road, Rte 89, Mulberry Road, Wormwood Hill Road, Rte 195 and Bassetts Bridge Road. (Note that Rte 195 is signed as a bike route here)

Mansfield (ECSU) Athletic Fields - 8.18 mi; 506 ft of climb
 Starting point: Parking lot at the ECSU ball fields & track on Mansfield City Road.
 Loop through southern Mansfield via Mansfield City Road, Pleasant Valley Road, Woods Road, Highland Road, Stearns Road, Mansfield City Road, Puddin Lane, Clearview Drive, Conantville Road and Meadowbrook Road.



Dairy Bar – 5 mi; 292 ft of climb

Starting point: UConn Dairy Bar Horsebarn Hill loop and a little of the UConn campus West of Rte 195

Nash-Zimmer – 6 mi; 336 ft of climb

Starting point: Transportation Center on Royce Circle in Downtown Storrs. Dog Lane, Hanks Hill Rd, South Eagleville Rd, Maple Rd, Spring Hill Rd and Rte 195 just South of Downtown Storrs. (Note that Rte 195 is not signed as a Bike Route here)

Community Center – 4.0 mi; 246 ft of climb

Starting point: Mansfield Community Ctr on South Eagleville Road. A loop around and through much of the northerly UConn campus via multi-use paths on Separatist and Hunting Lodge Roads and campus roadways.

Southeast – 6 mi; 333 ft of climb


Starting point: Playing fields next to Southeast School on Rte 89. Loop through Mansfield Center up Chaffeeville Road, across Mulberry Road and down Wormwood Hill Road back to Rte 89.

Boat Launch – 9 mi; 536 ft of climb

Starting point: The boat launch area in the Mansfield Hollow State Park on Bassetts Bridge Road. Loop through Atwoodville via N. Bedlam Road Atwoodville road, Rte 89, Mulberry Road, Wormwood Hill Road, Rte 195 and Bassetts Bridge Road (Note that Rte 195 is signed as a bike route here)

Mansfield (ECSU) Athletic Fields – 8.18 mi; 506 ft of climb

Starting point: Parking lot at the ECSU ball fields & track on Mansfield City Road. Loop through southern Mansfield via Mansfield City Road, Pleasant Valley Road, Woods Road, Highland Road, Stearns Road, Mansfield City Road, Puddin Lane, Clearview Drive, Conantville Road and Meadowbrook Road.

Bike Mansfield, a 501 (C)3 non-profit, was formed by area cyclists in 2017 to promote bicycle use and active transportation in the greater Mansfield area. With considerable assistance from the Town, it was successful in getting Mansfield certified as a Bicycle Friendly Community by the League of American Bicyclists in 2017. **This map** has been a Bike Mansfield project with financial support from the Thread City Cyclers and the Friends of Mansfield Hollow and assistance from the Town's Public Works Department, the Eastern Highlands Health District, the Mansfield Downtown Partnership and Clough Harbor Associates, whose work was all done pro bono.
