Dear Mansfield Staff and Families,

The large volume of COVID-19 cases within the general public is now having a greater effect on our schools. Today we saw a large number of new cases among members of our school community. In total, we were made aware of 8 cases. As some of you know, we also experienced a shortage of bus drivers today. Today's cases included one each at Goodwin and Vinton schools and 6 at the middle school. They resulted in few close contacts.

Reports from members of the public health community suggest we will continue to see high numbers of cases for another few weeks. Please know that teachers are creating individual learning plans for students who must stay home and often there are opportunities for students to participate in synchronous classroom instruction.

Schools will continue to work closely with families through these challenging times.
