Dear Mansfield Staff and Families,

We learned of a positive case of COVID-19 today within the Mansfield Middle School community. While there have been many cases of COVID within Mansfield, this is the first case of a school community member who attended school this week. Contact tracing was completed. Please remember that fully vaccinated individuals do not need to quarantine and others may qualify for Screen and Stay. We are doing all we can to keep our schools safe and reduce unnecessary time out of school for our students.

As always, we appreciate your efforts to closely monitor your child's health each morning so that you can keep home any child who is exhibiting signs of COVID-19. Recent media reports point out the prevalence of the Omicron variant focused in the nose and throat leading to cold-like symptoms or a sore throat.

As of the time of this communication, nearly all COVID test kits available for Mansfield students have been distributed. I will notify you when our second shipment of home tests is received.
