NEW! Wood Carving and Tool Sharpening (Ages 12-Adult)

Open to students of all levels of woodworking experience (beginners to advanced), come and learn the basics of several woodcarving methods including chip carving, letter carving, and designing and carving a Tudor Rose as you move through a series of projects! Skills obtained can be applied to sign carving, furniture making, toy making, and wood sculpture. In addition, participants will learn the steps for achieving proper cutting edge on hand tools. Please note tools are not provided. A list of suggested tools will be e-mailed once the class minimum is reached – expect to pay anywhere from \$50 – \$150 for new tools. Participants under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Instructor: *Randall Nelson*, a sculptor and wood carver with extensive experience, has for twenty years worked as both a teacher of arts and has managed his own sculptural restoration business. As a restoration sculptor you may recognize his work including the brownstone Soldiers and Sailors Arch in Bushnell Park

in Hartford and the famous brownstone McClellan Gate at Arlington National Cemetery.
