

PUBLIC HEARING

The Mansfield Planning and Zoning Commission will hold the following Public Hearing on **Monday, June 5, 2023, at 6:10 p.m., via a hybrid meeting** to consider updates and amendments to the Mansfield Zoning Regulations which include:

1. A complete reorganization of the Regulations to improve functionality and useability and to prepare for future codification;
2. Necessary regulatory amendments pursuant to CT Public Act 21-29, changes to CT Statute Statutes, identified caselaw and to improve consistency amongst the use of terms;
3. Enact language pertaining to electric vehicle charging station infrastructure and temporary or seasonal outdoor dining.

Copies of the proposed regulations, with updates, can be found on the Town's website and have been filed with the Office of the Town Clerk. At this meeting, public comments will be heard and written communications will be received.

Information on how to participate in the public hearing will be included in the Meeting Agenda available at least 48 hours prior to the hearing in the Town's Agenda Center (www.mansfieldct.gov/AgendaCenter). No information from the public shall be received after the close of the public hearings.
