The virtual public information meeting is being held to provide the public and local community the opportunity to offer comments or ask questions regarding the proposed project.

Right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed project will include partial takes (2 properties), Drainage Right of Way (1 property), Permanent slope easements (2 properties), Temporary Construction easements (2 properties) along with rights to grade, rights to construct driveways, and rights to remove and reconstruct stone walls. Construction is expected to start in Spring 2027 depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$4.55 Million with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
