

Board of Assessment Appeals Update – April 2020

In accordance with Governor Lamont's Executive Order 7B and social distancing guidelines recommended by the CDC to slow community spread of COVID-19, and Executive Order 7Z - Sec. 2 waiving the requirement of in-person Board of Assessment Appeals' Hearings, the remaining Mansfield Board of Assessment Appeals' hearings have been rescheduled and are being held remotely. Although they are now physically closed to the public, those wanting to listen may phone call into the hearings. There will be no public comment, however. Please note that these hearings are for appellants whose March 16th or March 23rd appointments had to be postponed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Board is not accepting new applications for appeal, as the deadline to file was February 20th, prior to changes caused by the pandemic.
